PRE-PARTICIPATION physical screenings for student athletes

Free sports physical screenings

Ministry Sports Medicine, part of Ascension, will be providing free pre-participation physical screenings (PPS) for area athletes as a convenience and cost savings for families. A PPS includes a complete medical history, sport-specific history, orthopedic and physical exam. Screenings are open to any athletes attending junior high or high school (grades 6-12) and meet all WIAA requirements for 2017-2019 seasons. The WIAA card and history form will need to be filled out prior to the screening. Parents need to be present for any athletes under 18 years of age. Please remember to wear a t-shirt and gym shorts.
