GUIDELINES FOR PUBLIC PARTICIPATION AT SCHOOL BOARD MEETINGS

1. The Board shall hear public comments at the proper time on the agenda.
2. Persons wishing to address the Board must register by filling out a Public Input card before the meeting is called to order. Those wishing to speak must provide their full name, address, and specify the topic they wish to address with the Board.
3. The Board President will determine whether the specified topic is appropriate for the public comment period. Questions or comments regarding individual personnel issues are not to be discussed in open session and will be tabled until a properly noticed closed session can deal with the issue.
4. Each speaker is limited to a maximum of five minutes
5. Persons who are not residents of the district may address the Board only if there are no objections on the part of the Board.
6. Citizen input during the rest of the meeting will only be allowed with the approval of the Board President. Any individual who interrupts the regular meeting without permission may be asked to leave.
7. Board members may listen to a speaker but do not have to answer or deliberate at the meeting on the concern raised.
