MEETING MINUTES

Date: September 19, 2012, at I-S Fitness & Aquatic Center

Call to Order: 7:06 p.m.

Secretary's Report: Minutes distributed; Laura motion to approve; Shawna seconded. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Concessions deposits in the amount of \$4,817.70, Memberships in the amount of \$3,935 in account. Outstanding bills; \$753.79 High School Building Maintenance Fund (soda bill), \$266.92 to Tom Anderson (Woodman's/Sam's Club), Invoice from Five Kids Shirt Co. for \$1,343.50. Follow up with Cathy about an additional fan wear deposit.

Motion to approve payment of outstanding bills to High School & Tom Anderson by Deanna seconded by Jon. Motion carried.

Five Kids Shirt Co. for \$1343.50 will not be paid at this time, amounts & quantities need to be verified.

Membership Committee: \$3,935 in memberships with an addition of \$200 from Ken & Charmaine Schreiber today. Five Kids Shirt Company will donate 10 Booster Club shirts to equal the Varsity Level Membership.

Concessions Committee: Gross \$5,023.66, Varsity football grossed largest (\$1,300-1,500) income, next largest is Middle School football (\$300-450), Varsity/JV volleyball (\$150), JV and Freshman football (\$100). Clubs earned \$756 in hourly wages so far, 189 hours of volunteer time by parents, students, booster club members, etc. Tentatively the concession stands in the black at approximately \$679. Tony requests approval to buy two cash trays (spring loaded, hinge locking top) @ \$34.29 each. Motion by Jon, Seconded by Travis, motion carried.

Mary suggests getting a completely metal tray in the future.

Jon Turba states that some kids are not satisfied getting \$4 an hour, not enough to get kids motivated to work. Will revisit "wage" after first year of operation, to ensure operation stays in the black.

Suggestion to provide Booster Club pins for concession stand workers. All agree it is a great idea. Will have some available at all concessions events.

Fanwear Committee: Two order forms, Holly will follow up with Cathy about an additional fan wear deposit. Find out about late orders and also Peskie order, who is it?

Next order and when due by has to be established.

Mary suggests that we have stuff for Homecoming Night.

Verify information, forward to committee, if satisfied, move ahead with planning and build a recommendation and email out for approval.
