HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

In order to be eligible for a high school diploma, students must meet the following graduation requirements.

1. Students must be in high school attendance eight semesters, unless otherwise provided.
2. Students must be enrolled in a class or participating in a Board-approved activity during each class period of each school day while attending high school.
3. Students must successfully complete 24 credits for graduation, including .25 credit of career education, 1 credit of consumer education, 4 credits of English, .5 credit of health education, 2 credits of mathematics, 1.5 credits of physical education, 2 credits of science, 3 credits of social studies, 1.5 credits of vocational education and/or foreign language, and 6.5 credits of electives. If a student does not meet this standard and he/she has an individualized education program (IEP), he/she must successfully complete the IEP goals as determined by the IEP team. If the student does not successfully complete the IEP goals, he/she must demonstrate to the graduation committee that he/she has met the Board's adopted academic standards.
4. Accommodations to the graduation requirements may be made for students with exceptional educational interests, needs or requirements in accordance with state law and regulations.
