TESTING PROGRAMS

The School District of Iola-Scandinavia shall establish and maintain a standardized basic testing program which can be used, communicated and interpreted by the schools and by the district.

The program shall lend itself to:

1. A qualitative assessment of the educational program of the district for purposes of reporting the overall status of the district and charting the growth of its students, grades, schools and areas from year to year.
2. Appropriate reports to the Board.
3. Interpretation and use by teachers, counselors and administrators so that the test findings will influence the guidance and counseling of individual students, and the development of a high quality curriculum.

The district's testing program shall embody those tests required by state laws and regulations.

Students with disabilities and English Language Learners (ELL) students shall participate in state-wide testing in accordance with state law and established procedures.

The School District of Iola-Scandinavia shall not discriminate in the methods, practices and materials used for testing, evaluating and counseling students on the basis of sex, race, color, national origin, ancestry, creed, religion, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, handicap or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
