

SELECTION OF INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS

The Board of Education is legally responsible for all matters relating to the operation of the school. Therefore, the Board is legally responsible for the final selection of all textbooks and library media center materials.

The District Administrator shall involve those teachers and principals who will be responsible for using the textbooks in a study of various textbooks suited for their particular grade level or subject area. Final adoption of textbooks shall be made based on information supplied by the District Administrator.

The Board delegates responsibility for the selection of library media center materials through the District Administrator and principals to the trained professional personnel in charge of the library media centers.

The District Administrator shall be responsible for setting up criteria and procedures by which supplemental classroom materials (e.g., supplementary books, maps, globes) may be provided and shall make provisions for the purchase of such materials within the annual budget submitted to the Board with due regard for the necessity and economical use of such material.

The School District of Iola-Scandinavia shall not discriminate in the selection and evaluation of instructional materials (e.g., textbooks, supplementary classroom materials, library media center materials) on the basis of sex, race, color, national origin, ancestry, creed, religion, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, handicap or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
