### GUIDANCE PROGRAM

A continuous program of guidance services shall be maintained in four-year-old kindergarten through grade 12. The program shall be designed to:

1. Help each student develop an understanding of his/her particular strengths and weaknesses and enable him/her to develop into a responsible citizen.
2. Help each student relate his/her interests, aptitudes and abilities to a meaningful program of studies and extracurricular activities.
3. Assist the student in career exploration, vocational and educational planning and goal setting.
4. Assist each student with personal and school concerns.

The guidance program shall be evaluated as part of the long-range plan.

The School District of Iola-Scandinavia shall not discriminate in the methods, practices and materials used for counseling, evaluating and testing students on the basis of sex, race, color, national origin, ancestry, creed, religion, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, handicap or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability.
