ADMISSION OF FOREIGN EXCHANGE PROGRAM STUDENTS

In order to ensure that proper planning can be done and the needs of district students can be served first, the following policy pertaining to the admission of foreign exchange program students shall be in effect.

1. No more than two foreign exchange program students may attend the district at one time.
2. Host families shall be approved by the high school principal.
3. The host family and sponsoring organization shall be responsible for any special programs, tours etc. provided for a foreign exchange program student.
4. The sponsoring organization is responsible for making sure that all applicable federal laws are followed.

Approved foreign exchange program students may attend school without payment of tuition.

The district shall assume no financial obligation for foreign exchange students based solely on their status as foreign exchange program students. For example, except as otherwise provided, the district shall not be responsible for providing free lunches or free school annuals.

Foreign exchange students may participate in the graduation ceremony if enrolled as a senior. Foreign exchange program students shall not receive a School District of Iola-Scandinavia high school diploma unless they have met the district's graduation requirements.

Any deviation from this policy must be approved by the High School Principal.
