### STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES TO THE BOARD

The Board of Education recognizes the unique perspective held by students on issues impacting the District. Therefore, the Board shall welcome two students to serve as representatives to the Board. These students shall represent the views of students enrolled in the District on agenda items discussed at Board meetings.

The student representative shall:

1. Attend Board meetings and sit at the table with the Board and be free to enter into discussion or answer questions in the same manner as elected Board members.
2. Represent all students in the District and communicate with student councils at all buildings and levels.
3. Be a member of the High School Student Council.
4. Be in tenth or eleventh grade when applying for the position of Student Representative to the Board.
5. Complete a Student Self-Nomination Form (see 441.2E) and submit it to the High School Student Council Advisor by March 30<sup>th</sup>.
6. Be elected by the Iola-Scandinavia High School class officers, student council officers, and faculty.
7. Serve for one year, beginning in May and concluding in April.
8. Not make or vote on motions.
9. Not participate in executive sessions or in the discussion of personnel employment or disciplinary matters.
10. Not be liable or responsible for actions taken by the Board.
