ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE HIGHER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

The district shall annually designate an academic scholar, for purposes of the Wisconsin Academic Excellence Higher Education Scholarship. The scholar shall be the senior with the highest grade point average (GPA) at the end of the first semester. The scholar shall be named in accordance with timelines required by law. The GPA shall be determined in accordance with established Board policy.

Students may compete for the scholarship in their fourth year of high school. To be eligible for the scholarship, students must attend Iola-Scandinavia High School for at least one high school year (any two semesters) and, in addition, successfully complete all of their senior year.

If two or more seniors have the same grade point average and are otherwise eligible to be designated a scholar, a committee of high school faculty members shall select the scholarship designee and certify, in descending rank order, those remaining seniors with the same grade point average as alternate designees.
