### FACULTY PROCEDURES FOR SELECTING ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE HIGHER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP DESIGNEE IN THE EVENT OF A TIE

If two or more seniors tie for the highest grade point average, a high school committee shall determine the scholarship designee and alternate(s) in rank order. The committee shall apply the following criteria in noted order:

1. The student with the higher (highest) score on the American College Test (ACT) shall be the district's scholarship designee.
2. If a tie still exists, the student with the higher (highest) Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) score shall be the district's scholarship designee.
3. If a tie still exists, the student who has earned the greater (greatest) number of credits shall be the district's scholarship designee. A student's total credits shall be based on all approved courses taken for high school credit while enrolled at Iola-Scandinavia High School, including courses taken for high school credit through the Youth Options program. For students transferring to the district, the credit total shall be determined by the counselor's review of their transcript from the previous school or educational program at the time of transfer.
4. If a tie still exists, the Board of Education will determine the designee.
