## ALCOHOL AND DRUG USE BY BUS DRIVERS

## **Prohibited Conduct**

School bus drivers shall be subject to the prohibitions included in the district's drug-free workplace policy. In addition, bus drivers shall be subject to the following specific prohibitions regarding use or being impaired by alcohol or other drugs:

- 1. Drivers shall be prohibited from any alcohol misuse that could affect performance of a safety-sensitive function including use on the job, use during the four hours before driving, having prohibited concentrations of alcohol in their systems while driving and use following an accident.
- 2. No driver shall report for duty or remain on duty requiring the performance of a safety-sensitive function when he/she uses any illegal drug or controlled substance, except when the use of a controlled substance is pursuant to the instructions of a physician who has advised the driver that the drug use does not adversely affect his/her ability to safely operate a motor vehicle.

## Drug and Alcohol Testing

In accordance with federal laws and regulations, an alcohol and drug testing program for school bus drivers shall be implemented.
