STAFF ACCEPTABLE USE AGREEMENT

Staff using district network resources to access the Internet and other on-line computer networks will agree to abide by the following acceptable use agreement.

The staff acceptable use agreement consists of the following regulations:

1. The district encourages and allows staff to use district network resources for educational and research purposes that are consistent with the educational objectives of the district.
2. Staff members are prohibited from using district network resources:
 - a. To post or transmit through any on-line network or try to find unlawful, harmful, threatening, abusive, harassing, defamatory, vulgar, obscene, profane, hateful, racially demeaning, ethnically demeaning or otherwise objectionable or inappropriate material of any kind. This includes, but is not limited to, any material that encourages conduct that would constitute a criminal offense or otherwise violate Board policy.
 - b. To disclose the personal information of minors without authorization
 - c. To play multi-user dimension (MUDs) or other network intensive games.
 - d. To use Internet relay chat (IRC) for non-educational use.
 - e. To improperly use copyrighted material.
 - f. To attempt unauthorized access to other computer systems.
 - g. To seek information on, obtain copies of, or modify files, other data, or passwords belonging to other users, or misrepresent themselves on the networks.
 - h. To disrupt the use of systems by others. Hardware or software shall not be destroyed, modified, or abused in any way.
 - i. To engage in any unlawful activity.
 - j. For any other computer network use deemed to be inappropriate.

The District Administrator, District Technology Coordinator, and/or Building Principals may monitor all network use by staff, including E-mail, to see that district network resources are being used in accordance with established handbooks, policies, guidelines and procedures.

Misuse of district network resources to access the Internet and other on-line computer networks may result in school disciplinary action. Appropriate legal action may also be taken.
