BOMB THREATS

In the event a bomb threat is made against a school or other district property, the following procedures are recommended:

1. The school or other building shall be evacuated immediately.
2. If the threat was not originally received through the fire, police or sheriff's department, fire and law enforcement departments shall be notified immediately. Both fire and law enforcement departments should respond.
3. A search of the building or property should be conducted under the direction of the senior law enforcement officer present. Circumstances will dictate whether any strange or foreign objects should be removed immediately or left for removal by a qualified person.
4. The senior law enforcement officer present will notify the chief administrative officer of the school or building when it is safe to re-enter the building.

Any decision concerning the dismissal of students and subsequent action after the above procedures have been followed shall be the responsibility of the District Administrator.

An investigation of the incident should be conducted by the appropriate law enforcement department, with assistance of the state fire marshal's office if requested.
