

BUILDING AND GROUNDS MAINTENANCE

The district shall strive to maintain buildings, grounds and equipment in first class condition by implementing a program of continuous repair, reconditioning, remodeling and improvement. The reconditioning, remodeling and improvement of school buildings shall be considered in light of the Board's policy of maintaining buildings with a high degree of efficiency.

Adequate grounds shall be maintained for the educational and recreational use of school children. The overall requirements for providing such grounds shall be reviewed annually by the Buildings and Grounds Committee. The Board also recognizes the value of attractive landscaping consistent with economy in cost and operation.

Requests shall be considered by the Buildings and Grounds Committee with recommendations made to the full Board. The Board may approve expenditures for major repair, reconditioning, remodeling and improvement projects from either the general fund budget or the building fund budget.

An annual building maintenance schedule shall be developed by the Director of Buildings and Grounds and approved by the Board.
