BUS ROUTING AND SCHEDULING

The Transportation Director shall establish bus routes for the district. In determining bus routes, the Transportation Director shall use his/her discretion and take into consideration time and distance and safety in regard to the distance a child may be expected to walk to the nearest pick-up point. Bus routes and schedules shall be submitted to the Board for final approval.

Children enrolled in grades kindergarten through three, in order to facilitate transportation, may be expected to walk up to 1/4 mile from their driveway to the nearest bus pick-up point. Children enrolled in grades four through five may be expected to walk up to 3/10ths of a mile from their driveway to the nearest bus pick-up point. Children enrolled in grades six through eight may be expected to walk up to 4/10ths of a mile from their driveway to the nearest bus pick-up point. Children enrolled in grades nine through twelve may be expected to walk up to 1/2 of a mile from their driveway to the nearest bus pick-up point.

If the route indicates that the bus should turn around at a private party's driveway, that party shall provide a safe turn around including making sure that snow is removed.

Upon request of a student's parent/guardian, and at the discretion of the Director of Transportation, a student's regular pick-up/drop-off point may be changed to a point other than that assigned for the student's residence. Such a change in pick-up/drop-off point will be made only if it can be accomplished without increasing the length of the bus route or the number of stops the buses make, and only if the bus capacity allows.
