### FOOD SERVICES MANAGEMENT

The district shall provide hot lunches through participation in the National School Lunch Program. The District Administrator, or his/her designee, shall enter into an agreement with the Department of Public Instruction (DPI) and the federal government for participation in such child nutrition program.

It shall be the purpose of the food service program to provide nourishing well-balanced meals at moderate prices in pleasant surroundings. In addition, the program provides a teaching situation in which the foods that children need for proper growth and development are served in an appetizing manner so they will be readily accepted.

The Food Service Director shall be responsible for the management of the food services program, under the direction of the District Administrator.

Food service prices shall be established annually by the Board.

The Iola-Scandinavia School District shall not discriminate in school-sponsored food service programs on the basis of sex, race, color, national origin, ancestry, creed, religion, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, handicap or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
