FREE AND REDUCED PRICE FOOD SERVICES

The district shall take part in the National School Lunch Program to assure that all children in the district receive proper nourishment. In accordance with the guidelines for participation in this program, no child who a teacher believes is improperly nourished shall be denied a free lunch, or other food, simply because proper application has not been received from his/her parent/guardian.

In identifying children to receive free and reduced price food services federal guidelines will be followed. In making individual determinations and in providing the free or reduced price food services, every effort shall be made to avoid overt identification to the peers of children receiving such meals. No child shall be required to work for free or reduced price food services.

Application forms shall be available to parents/guardians of children who may request free or reduced price food services and a file of applications and/or authorizations shall be maintained in accordance with established guidelines.

The Business Manager shall maintain a system of collecting payments from paying children and accounting for free and reduced price food services in a manner which will protect the anonymity of children receiving free or reduced price food services.

Any appeal of the decision shall be referred to the District Administrator.
